

## MOE Bursary

Bursaries under this scheme are funded by MOE and are administered by Yale-NUS. The scheme is offered to applicants who are Singapore Citizens with gross monthly household per capita income (PCI\*) is not more than \$2,250 or gross monthly household income (GHI\*\*) is not more than \$9,000.

Value and Eligibility	Full-time Singapore Citizen students who are pursuing the first undergraduate degree and paying the subsidized tuition fee. Their PCI or GHI should be within the range listed below.

Tenure	Annual. Re-application is necessary every year.		
Repayment	No repayment is required. Should a student withdraw from the program or is asked to leave the program, the bursary must be refunded in part or in full.		
Conditions	<p>Students may not concurrently hold other scholarship, study award/grant or bursary (including CDC/CCC) in the same year as the MOE bursary except for the following</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Students who are awarded Mendaki's Tertiary Tuition Fee Subsidy (TTFS) may concurrently hold the MOE Bursary. TTFS is used to cover the tuition fees.</li> <li>2. Awards or bursaries related to overseas exchange programs.</li> </ol>		

\* Monthly per capita household income (PCI) refers to the total income of all those living in the household divided by the number of people in the household.

\*\* Gross monthly household income (GHI) refers to the total income of all those living in the household.
